Our CRIC (Clinical Research Imaging Centre) will house:

- Magnetic resonance - Positron emission tomography (MR-PET) scanner
- 3T wide bore MRI scanner (MR-3T)
- Two PET-CT scanners
- Cyclotron
- MHRA accredited radiochemistry suite (GMP and R&D)
- Multi-modal retinal imaging (e.g. fundus camera, optical coherence tomography)
- Image analysis suite

PLUS our **BRIC (Brain Research Imaging Centre)** will house hospital-embedded MR scanners at two Edinburgh sites:

- 1.5T neuro-optimised MRI scanner (based at the WGH)
- 3T neuro-optimised MRI scanner (based at the RIE)
